Cover type groups include the following: SWAMP HARDWOOD=elm-ash-cottonwood, balsam poplar, SWAMP CONIFER=tamarack, cedar, black spruce, ASPEN=aspen, UPLAND CONIFER=pinus, white spruce, balsam fir, and UPLAND HARDWOOD=maple-beech-birch, paper birch, oak-hickory. 1000 cubic feet = approximately 12.7 cords or 7000-8000 board feet.
